Air travel in to Spain – Madrid, Barcelona or Bilbao Airport

FROM MADRID TO PAMPLONA:

International Flights arrive in Terminal T1 of the MADRID-BARAJAS AIRPORT (also called Adolfo Suarez Airport) <http://www.aeropuertomadrid-barajas.com/eng/madrid-airport-terminals.htm>

To get to Pamplona you have 3 options:

- **Flight** to PAMPLONA: Flights are limited. Additionally you will need to change / move to Terminal T4 via walking and the airport underground train. Costs will vary.
- **Train** to PAMPLONA: First, you need to take a TAXI (located outside of Terminal T1) to the ATOCHA Rail Station (using Madrid – Atocha as the (from)/departure location, Pamplona as the (to)/destination location. Taxi takes approximately 20 minutes and costs approximately 30€. The Rail company is RENFE (<http://www.renfe.com>). The journey to Pamplona takes approximately 3-4 hours. *The duration and ticket price depends on the type of train, date/time of travel, and date of purchase (ie, advanced ticket purchase is less expensive).* Approximate cost of the train is 30-75€, one way.
- **Bus** to PAMPLONA: You will need to get from Terminal T1 to Terminal T4, via walking and the airport underground train. The Bus stop is located in Terminal T4. The link to ALSA the bus company to obtain the tickets <https://www.alsa.es/en/our-destinations/airports/madrid-barajas-airport>. Use Madrid - Barajas Airport T4 as the (from)/departure location, and Pamplona as the (to)/destination location. The journey to Pamplona takes approximately 4 – 5 hours. *The duration and ticket price depends on the date/time of travel, and date of purchase (ie, advanced ticket purchase is less expensive).* Approximate cost of the bus is 19 – 50€, one way.

FROM BARCELONA TO PAMPLONA:

International Flights arrive in via Terminal T1 or Terminal T2 of the EL PRAT AIRPORT <http://www.aeropuertobarcelona-elprat.com/ingl/index.html>.

To get to Pamplona you have 3 options:

- **Flight** to PAMPLONA: Flights are limited and you may have to change terminals. There is a **free shuttle service** that connects terminals T1 and T2. http://www.aeropuertobarcelona-elprat.com/ingl/aeropuerto_de_barcelona.htm
- **Train** to PAMPLONA: First, you need to get to the SANTS Rail Station (you have 2 options):
 - Take a **TAXI**, available outside of both Terminal T1 and Terminal T2 to the **SANTS Rail Station**. It takes 20 minutes. The cost is approximately 25€. http://www.adif.es/en_US/infraestructuras/estaciones/71801/informacion_000097.shtml.
 - Take the “**R2 train line**” from the airport (outside of the Terminal T2) to SANTS rail Station http://www.aeropuertobarcelona-elprat.com/ingl/accesos_aeropuerto_tren4010.htm approximately 19 minutes.

The Rail company is called RENFE and tickets can be booked at <http://www.renfe.com> (This is the same company out of Madrid). Using Barcelona-SANTS as the (from)/departure location, and Pamplona as the (to)/destination location. The journey to Pamplona takes approximately 3.5-4.5 hours. The duration and ticket price depends on the type of train, date/time of travel, and date of purchase (ie, advanced ticket purchase is less expensive). Approximate cost is between 32-70€, one way)

- **Bus** to PAMPLONA: Limited bus departures to Pamplona. First, you need to get to the SANTS Bus Station, which is in the same place than the SANTS Train Station, use same two options to arrive at the Bus Station from the airport.
 - Take a **TAXI**, available outside of both Terminal 1 and Terminal 2 to the **SANTS rail Station** It takes 20min. and costs +25€. http://www.adif.es/en_US/infraestructuras/estaciones/71801/informacion_000097.shtml .
 - Take the “**R2 train line**” from the airport (outside of the Terminal 2) to SANTS rail Station http://www.aeropuertobarcelona-elprat.com/ingl/accesos_aeropuerto_tren4010.htm approximately 19 minutes.
 - Link to buy the tickets <http://www.monbus.es/en> The name of the bus company is VIBASA (identified on the side of the bus).

Using Barcelona-SANTS as the (from)/departure location, and Pamplona as the (to)/destination location. The journey take approximately 5-6 hours. Approximate cost of the bus is 15 – 35€. *The duration and ticket price depends on the date/time of travel, and date of purchase (ie, advanced ticket purchase is less expensive).*

FROM BILBAO TO PAMPLONA:

Bilbao International Airport has only one Terminal. Various European international flights arrive and depart from Bilbao International. US attendees would need to arrive in Bilbao from another connecting flight from a major city in Europe.

Two options to get to Pamplona:

- **Personal Car Rental** – Costs vary based on personal/vehicle preferences and including duration of rental. <http://www.rentalcars.com/AirportLandingPage.do;jsessionid=DD25166D679DA4F9D25C54772B350DEC.node040a>
- **Bus to PAMPLONA:** First you must take a TAXI or a BUS to Bilbao Bus Station - <http://www.termibus.es/> which is in the City Center. The bus company is <https://www.alsa.es/en>. (ALSA identified on the side of the bus) Tickets may be purchased online or can be purchased at the bus station LA BURUNDESA / AUTOBUSES LA UNION <http://www.autobuseslaunion.com/en/index.asp>. The travel time is approximately 2.5 hours. Approximate cost is 15€.

FROM PAMPLONA'S AIRPORT/TRAIN STATION/BUS STATION TO THE HOTEL, Regardless of your route of arrival into Pamplona, the best option to get to your hotel is to take a TAXI. Pamplona is a tiny town, you can get to your hotel from the airport, train station or bus station, in approximately 20 minutes. <http://www.taxipamplona.com/en>
