




Using Guidebook at the 13th International Family Nursing Conference





FAQs

Q: When will Guidebook for IFNC13 be available?

A: Guidebook for IFNC13 is available now! The full schedule is being updated as it becomes available.

Q: How do I get Guidebook for IFNC13 on my phone or tablet?

A: Go to <http://guidebook.com/g/ifnc13> on your mobile device to download the app. When you open the Guidebook app, look for the guide: “13th International Family Nursing Conference”

Q: Will there be a paper/printed schedule available at IFNC13?

A: Yes. Guidebook will not replace the standard printed schedule at the conference. The official guide will be available at registration.

Q: Will I need phone service in Pamplona to use Guidebook?

A: No. You will need to use a wireless connection or cellular data service to download the guide and to receive updates to the schedule, but you do not need data or phone service to use Guidebook once it is on your device. You can set your phone to “airplane mode” to minimize data use at the venue. *You can turn off wireless completely, but you will not be able to access external links or receive updates to the guide unless you have wireless Internet availability.*

Q: Why should I download the IFNC13 guide now, before the conference?

A: We’ve designed the mobile guide to help IFNC13 attendees plan for the conference in advance. Explore the guide to plan your schedule, explore maps of the local area, and start connecting with others who will be in Pamplona for the conference.

Q: Do I need an active Twitter account to see the IFNC13 Twitter feed?

A: You do not need an active Twitter account to see the live Twitter feed in Guidebook for IFNC13. However, linking Guidebook with a Twitter account will enable you to “live tweet” at the conference, and we encourage attendees to use social media during the conference.
