- Who would benefit from IFNC17? Nurses AND non-nurses in healthcare engaging with and advocating for families who want to strengthen families through research, education, practice, and/or policy.
- Why attend IFNC17? Join a global network of clinicians, educators, and researchers committed to advancing family health. Engage with new and former colleagues, build collaborative networks, generate new ideas, and further scholarship.
- How can I attend? You can attend in-person or virtually.
- Do I need to be a member of IFNA to attend? You do not need to be a member to attend but you do need to be a member to present in any format.
- What will in-person attendance provide? Please join us *in person* at the Crown Perth in June 2025 for an engaging experience. Attend interactive workshops, keynote presentations, expert lectures, and oral and poster presentations. Make it a *"destination conference"* and take time to explore Perth, Western Australia and beyond.
- What if I cannot attend in person? If you cannot join in person, you can register for the virtual, asynchronous option.
- What does the virtual asynchronous option include? All previously recorded keynote, expert lectures, oral and poster presentations will be included in the virtual asynchronous option.
- Will I be able to engage with presenters live if I register for the virtual asynchronous option? We are exploring options for presenter-participant active engagement. Virtual registrants will be able to contact any presenters who include their contact information on their presentation slides.
- When will the previously recorded sessions be available? All previously recorded presentations will be *available* shortly after the live presentation. You can select a time to view the presentations at your convenience.
- Will recorded sessions be available to those who attend in-person? Yes. Anyone who registers for the in-person *or* virtual, asynchronous option will have access to the recordings.
- Can I present if I register for the virtual asynchronous option? Yes, poster presentations are welcomed from anyone registering for the virtual asynchronous option. This is a great opportunity to increase your visibility during the conference when you cannot be physically present.
- What is the format for presenting virtual posters? Once accepted, poster presenters will be asked to submit their poster with a 3-minute recording by a designated date. Virtual posters will scroll on a monitor during the conference. Posters with recordings will be available during and after the conference.
- Will presentations be live-streamed? No. Due to the international audience and multiple time zones, live-streaming is not feasible. However, all recorded presentations will be *available shortly after* the live in-person presentation.
