 - Early registration (ends May 1st) for members = \$550.00 US dollars with other options available
 - Registration includes attendance at workshops

- **How do I prepare for travel to IFNC17 in Perth?**
 - Most importantly, make sure your **passport** is up-to-date (approximately 6 months beyond the conference).
 - Apply for a **visa**. All non-Australian citizens will need a visa to enter Australia

- **Do I need any vaccinations to enter or travel in Australia?** No, evidence of vaccination status is not needed.
- **What is the weather like in Australia in June?**
 - June - August is the “low” or winter season & described as cool and cloudy, but with plenty of sunshine to enjoy.
 - In Perth temperatures range from 8 - 19°C (46.4 - 66.2°F). In Australia, 11°C (52°F) (south) to 30°C (86°F) (north).
 - Benefits of traveling at this time include: less tourists, cheaper flights and great deals on accommodations.
